



ALLYSON REYNOLDS AT REBECCA HOSSACK

Rebecca Hossack Gallery at 35 Windmill Street, W1, is hosting an exhibition of work by Allyson Reynolds, a young Australian artist who specialises in working in oil on linen. This lends her art an amazing translucency, as do the moths



which form the subject matter of her latest series of paintings. The large scale of the works enhance their beauty even further. Allyson often takes inspiration from nature, in all its irregularity and simplicity. Though carefully worked, her paintings hint at something quite incidental, as if several moths had indeed just landed within the frame. The artist's lightness of touch evokes the delicacy of the natural world.
