**IN HIS OWN MIND:** Stephen was not even famous for being except among a small clique. himself as a poet, he saw as a painter, and most other saw him as a dabbler, a love-freak. **FOR PLEASURE:** It is not to think that David has been making prints for a century. There are those who think it is what he does best. This little retrospective

**ARCHITECTURAL:** Edward Allington is a sculptor whose work constantly aspires to the condition of architecture, or at least makes constant reference to it, directly or allegorically. **PLAYING POSSUM:** It is not just the name which makes Clifford Possum Tjapaltjarri stick in the mind. He was

probably the first Aboriginal artist we encountered, but it is now clear that he is also the best.
