Inspired by the colour and abstract pattern-making of masters such as Matisse and Braque, Dione Verulam has used her old mono-prints, etchings and watercolours, as well as antique book-binding papers, to create a series of vibrant collages depicting favourite pastimes, such as picnicking and travel. Scenes such as *Siesta Sur l'Herbe*, *Pyrenees* and *Searching for Truffles* show her familiar motifs of horses, hounds and the hunt reappearing in new landscapes.
