One of Fitzrovia's longest established residents, Australian born Rebecca Hossack manages a second space in nearby Charlotte Street which is showing *Soliloguy*, a series of dreamlike and

fantasy themed photographs by Queensland artist Toby Burrows on now until 1 April.
