Mr Possum, who is one of Australia's leading artists, is the first Aboriginal to hold a one-man exhibition in Europe. Another first for Mr Possum will be his trip to London to attend his exhibition and a reception at Buckingham Palace.

Mr Possum lives and works in the Todd River creek bed, near Alice Springs in central Australia, where he produces highly individual works which centre around his tribal totems — Possum, Water, Rainbow Snake and Kangaroo.
