A MAJOR exhibition of Aboriginal art has opened at London's Rebecca Hossack Gallery. The six-month exhibition will be in four phases depicting different regions of Aboriginal culture in Australia. The first features paintings depicting Dreamtime stories from the Balgo Hills, a remote settlement 600 kilometres north-west of Alice Springs. From 9 April Aboriginal artefacts will be on show. Works by urban Aboriginal artist Robert Campbell junior (14 May-15 June) and bark paintings from Western Australia (6-31 August) will also be exhibited.
