Kauage criticised the

lack of Government support in promoting PNG art internationally. He said he had not received any incentive from the Government and neither did other artists like himself.

He said the arts industry was one of many potential revenue earner that the Government had overlooked.

His son John Kagl said "the demand (for PNG art) is overseas but there is no support from the Government to promote it". He said paintings such as his father's work sold well overseas and would be a big money-spinner if helped.

Kauage said the Government must try to help artists who were working hard to promote PNG's art and culture overseas.

Tanorama chairwoman and playwright Nora Vagi Brash said the Government should support artists, particularly when there were chances to promote PNG art and culture overseas.

Kauage will visit Germany to host a private exhibition before returning to PNG
