Australian-born Rebecca Hossack has championed Australian and Indigenous Australian art in her London-based galleries for more than 25 years. Here, her picks for Australian Indigenous artists to buy now.

Owen Yalandja: "A brilliant sculptor, from Maningrida of central Arnhem Land, he carves, then paints, mysterious fish-tailed mermaid-figures yawkyawk. They have both an assured restraint and a sinuous energy."

Lloyd Kwilla: "One of the younger generation of painters to emerge from the Kimberly region of north Western Australia. Kwilla uses ochres to create images of great formal elegance, that seem to connect directly with the land they depict."

Jonathan Jones: "A young Sydney-based Aboriginal, Jonathan Jones assembles quietly powerful sculptures using electric light."

Jimmy Pike (c1940-2002): "Born in the Western Australian desert, Pike has a strong traditional understanding but combines this with an individual artistic vision: brilliantly controlled bands of colour, vivid motifs and a dash of humour."
